





Consultation on change of age range to allow for spaces for Under 4's at Browick Road Primary School from September 2017

Introduction

The purpose of this document is to discuss proposed changes to the provision at Browick Road Primary School for under 4's which requires a lowering of the schools age range by 2 years. Norfolk County Council agrees with the school's Governing Body proposal to consult on the proposed changes in line with legal requirements.

The consultation period will run for 3 weeks from **Monday 8th May** to **Friday 26th May 2017**. Norfolk County Council will consider all comments received during the consultation period. We are consulting with all relevant stakeholders as required by law when making changes to school age range arrangements.

What change is being proposed?

Currently the school takes children into the Reception Class at the start of school year after their fourth birthday. All younger children attend Busy Bees Playgroup or alternative Early Years provision within Wymondham.

From September 2017 a merger with Busy Bees Playgroup is proposed, thereby lowering our school's age range to admit 2 year olds. As part of this merger the school will take on the management of the playgroup and will be known as Browick Road Primary and Nursery School. This will make the schools age range 2 - 11 years, rather than the current 4 - 11 years.

Please note that there is no change proposed to the determined admissions arrangements. The school's determined admission arrangements for school entry in September 2018 remain unchanged and there is no change to the fact that a nursery place does not in any way guarantee a place at the school, as is documented on the admissions policy on the school web site.

Norfolk County Council believes this change will;

- protect the current number of early year places in the immediate area
- ensure a sustainable governance structure for the early years provision.

Why is the school making this change?

The school was approached by the Busy Bees management committee with regard to a merger due to difficulties in recruiting committee members. A voluntary playgroup has a legal duty to run by an effective committee and it has proved increasingly difficult to recruit to this voluntary role. This has an impact on the sustainability of the playgroup and staff security. The school and playgroup see this as a positive and exciting move which will strengthen the partnership between both settings.

Will the proposed change result in any impact on current Busy Bees provision?

From September 2017, Browick Road Primary School intends that the new provision will reflect the current Busy Bees model, in that the older children will be prioritised in the morning, with the option of additional afternoon sessions in line with the introduction of the 30 hours funding https://www.norfolk.gov.uk/children-and-families/childcare-and-early-learning/free-childcare-and-learning/free-childcare-and-families/childcare-and-early-learning/free-childcare-and-learning/free-childcare-and-families/childcare-

Will the proposed change result in additional traffic near the school at drop off and pick up times?

There will not be any impact on peak time traffic at the school, as the provision is already on the school site.

What will the impact be of providers of nursery provision locally?

We cannot foresee any impact on other providers locally as new places are not being created.

The earliest this could happen is 1 September 2017.
