NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Proposal to alter the SEN provision; currently a 10 place Learning & Cognition Needs (LCN) Specialist Resource Base (SRB), to establish a 20 place LCN SRB, at Hillside Primary (Community) School, Bradwell from 1st January 2023.

Notice is hereby given that Norfolk County Council approves the above statutory proposal as set out in the public notice to alter the existing Learning and Cognition Specialist Resource Base, by expanding the provision from 10 place to a 20 place SRB, at Hillside Primary School, Bradwell, Norfolk form 1 January 2023.

This proposal under 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, is to make a prescribed alteration to Hillside Primary School, Lords Lane, Bradwell, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk NR31 8PA, to increase the number of places from 10 places to a 20 place LCN SRB, from 1 January 2023.

The reasons for this decision are that:

- The statutory procedural requirements have been met
- The proposal meets the criteria laid down in statutory guidance in relation to the likely impact of the proposal on standards and school improvement, local choice and diversity, surplus places, community cohesion and race equality
- The views of all interested parties, including those most likely to be affected, have been considered.
- There were no objections to the proposal during the statutory Public Notice period.
