NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Proposal to alter SEN provision by expanding the 10 place Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) Specialist Resource Base (SRB) on the site at Millfield Primary School, Recreation Road, North Walsham, NR28 0ES. The provision will be expanded by adding a further 6 places to make a 16 place SRB.

Notice is hereby given that Norfolk County Council **approves** the above statutory proposal as set out in the public notice issued on 29 April 2021, to alter the SEN provision.

This proposal under 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, is to make a prescribed alteration at Millfield Primary School, Recreation Road, North Walsham, NR28 0ES, to alter the SEN provision by adding 6 places to the Autistic Spectrum Disorder Specialist Resource Base, from 1 September 2021.

The reasons for this decision are that:

- The statutory procedural requirements have been met
- The proposal meets the criteria laid down in statutory guidance in relation to the likely impact of the proposal on standards and school improvement, local choice and diversity, surplus places, community cohesion and race equality
- The views of all interested parties, including those most likely to be affected, have been considered.
- There were no objections to the proposal during the statutory Public Notice period.
