Proposal for all school children in the North Yarmouth area, to go to **one** primary school on the North Denes site

If we go ahead with the proposal:

- All children at Alderman Swindell Primary School will move to one primary school, from September 2018 on the North Denes Primary School site.
- A new school building will be built on the North Denes Primary School site
- The school will be bigger, with up to 420 children.
- The school could get bigger if needed.
- There will be a nursery for 2 – 4 year olds on the North Denes site.

If we go ahead with the proposal:

- All children at North Denes Primary School will stay at a school on the North Denes site.
- All children from Alderman Swindell Primary School will move to the primary school on the North Denes site, from September 2018
- A new school building will be built on the North Denes Primary School site, by September 2020
- The school will be bigger, with up to 420 children.
- The school could get bigger if needed.
- There will be a nursery for 2 – 4 year olds on the North Denes site.

If at the end of the consultation process, the proposal does not go forward then the schools stay as they are.

We would also like to seek your views on;

We are keen to make sure that all Great Yarmouth children go to a school in the area that they live. This means that we are looking at different uses for the Alderman Swindell Primary School site. This could be to meet the needs of children and young people who cannot be educated in a mainstream school.
