## NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

## Proposal to increase the number of Specialist Resource Base places at Sprowston Infant School

Notice is hereby given that Norfolk County Council **approves** the above statutory proposal as set out in the public notice to increase the number of Specialist Resource Base places at Sprowston Infant School from 1 February 2020.

This proposal under 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, is to make a prescribed alteration to Sprowston Infant School, to increase the number of places at the Complex Needs Specialist Resource Base, from 10 places to 18 places, from 1 February 2020.

The reasons for this decision are that:

- The statutory procedural requirements have been met
- The proposal meets the criteria laid down in statutory guidance in relation to the likely impact of the proposal on standards and school improvement, local choice and diversity, surplus places, community cohesion and race equality
- The views of all interested parties, including those most likely to be affected, have been considered.
- There were no objections to the proposal during the statutory Public Notice period.
