

Proposed significant change to six Norfolk primary phase schools

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that, Norfolk County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to the following schools, in accordance with section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, by establishing Specialist Resource Bases in each school, as detailed below;

Falcon Junior School Norwich	8 place additional intervention base	From 1 September 2024
Holly Meadows Primary School, King's Lynn	16 place early intervention/ additional intervention base	From 1 September 2025
Necton VA Primary School, Swaffham	10 place Speech Language and Communication needs base	From 1 September 2025
Redcastle Family School, Thetford	16 place early intervention/ additional intervention base	From 1 February 2024
Sprowston Junior School, Norwich	16 place additional intervention base	From 1 September 2025
St William's Primary School, Norwich	16 place social, emotional and mental health base	From 1 September 2025
