NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

The proposal is to establish a 16 place specialist resource base; 8 place early intervention base for Key Stage 1 pupils and an 8 place additional intervention base for Key Stage 2 pupils at Redcastle Family School, from 1 February 2024.

Notice is hereby given that Norfolk County Council **approves** the above statutory proposal as set out in the public notice to establish a 16 place specialist resource base; 8 place early intervention base for Key Stage 1 pupils and an 8 place additional intervention base for Key Stage 2 pupils at Redcastle Family School, from 1 February 2024.

This proposal under Section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, is to make a prescribed alteration on the site at Redcastle Family School, to establish a 16 place specialist resource base; 8 place early intervention base for Key Stage 1 pupils and an 8 place additional intervention base for Key Stage 2 pupils at Redcastle Family School, from 1 February 2024.

The reasons for this decision are that:

- The statutory procedural requirements have been met
- The proposal meets the criteria laid down in statutory guidance in relation to the likely impact of the proposal on standards and school improvement, local choice and diversity, surplus places, community cohesion and race equality
- The views of all interested parties, including those most likely to be affected, have been considered.
- There were no objections to the proposal during the statutory Public Notice period.
