**Proposal to alter SEN provision by expanding the 10 place Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) Specialist Resource Base on the site at Mundesley Infant (Community) School and Mundesley Junior (Community) School, Trunch Road, Mundesley, Norwich, Norfolk NR11 8LE, the provision will be expanded by adding a further 6 places at Mundesley Junior (Community) School**

Notice is hereby given that Norfolk County Council **approves** the above statutory proposal as set out in the public notice to alter the SEN provision by adding 6 places to the Social, Emotional and Mental Health Specialist Resource Base, from 1 September 2020.


This proposal under 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013, is to make a prescribed alteration to Mundesley Junior (Community) School, Trunch Road, Mundesley Norwich NR11 8LE, to alter the SEN provision by adding 6 places to the Social, Emotional and Mental Health Specialist Resource Base, from 1 September 2020.
