Overview

In March 2021 the Government published its National Bus Strategy which was called 'Bus Back Better.' The government wants to improve bus services across England and has asked local councils to help them. In October 2021, Norfolk County Council published their 'Bus Service Improvement Plan', which has lots of ideas about how buses can be improved in Norfolk.


D) Introduce tickets that can be used across all the different buses in Norfolk








E) Introduce a rule where you can't get charged above a certain price for fares. This is called 'fare capping'.






 Introduce more real time information at stops, so for example you would be able to see how far away the next bus is while at the bus stop.
