# Your views on our proposal to save money by reducing the opening hours of the Norfolk Record Office





Some of the things in this paper are not easy to understand.

The Norfolk Record Office collects and keeps old items relating to the history of Norfolk.



The Norfolk Record Office also runs education classes and gives advice for people accessing the old items.



The Norfolk Record Office also offers a public search room where people can get information.



#### Currently, the office opens Tuesday to Friday, 10am to 5pm - 28 hours per week.







Our proposal is to close the office on a Friday, but to extend the opening hours on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, by opening half an hour earlier.

This means the office's new opening hours would be from Tuesday to Thursday, from 9.30am to 5pm. If our proposals are approved, the office will be open for 22.5 hours each week in the future.



This proposal would save us £22,000 in 2023/2024.
