To do this, we spend over a billion pounds each year.

We must be sure the money we spend matches the money we get in. This is hard to do at the moment.

> Things are getting more expensive. The money we get in isn't covering what things now cost.



We need to save money by cutting what we spend. We have been saving money between 2011 and 2022. However, we need to save another £32.5 million in 2022.

Our idea is about **recycling centres.** There are 20 recycling centres in Norfolk.



Recycling Centres are places where people can recycle and dispose of some of their household waste.





Recycling centres now **open at 9am and close at 5pm** in summer. The summer months are from the start of April to the end of September.





Our idea is to open recycling centres at **9am and close at 4pm in summer.** They will be open for one hour less each day in summer than they are now.



The opening hours will be the same all year round. Recycling centres will open at 9am and close at 4pm in winter and in summer.



Our idea would save us around £70,000 next year.
