How things are



We want Norfolk to be a county where everyone thrives together.



We have a plan called **Together, for Norfolk** to make Norfolk a good place to work and live.



Life is difficult for everyone now because of COVID-19. We continue to provide vital services to support people in Norfolk.



To do this we spend over a billion pounds each year.



We must be sure the money we spend matches the money we get in. This is hard to do at the moment.



It costs more money to provide services with COVID-19.



Things are getting more expensive. The money we get in isn't covering what things now cost.



We are getting less money from the Government, and the money we will get in future is not clear.



What do we need to do now?

This means we need to get more money in. We also need to save more money.



We get money from people who live in Norfolk. This is called council tax. We use this money to pay for local services. We are asking people to pay more council tax next year.



We will also ask the Government for money. The extra money we get from council tax and the Government still won't pay all our bills.



We need to save money by cutting what we spend. We saved £436 million between 2011 and 2020. That is a lot of money, but we need to save another £26 million in 2021.



We have had one idea to save money. Please give us your thoughts on it.

Our idea



We look after grass cutting along roads in urban and rural areas in Norfolk. Our idea is to spend less money by cutting the grass less often.



We would cut the grass 4 times a year along urban roads, instead of 5 times a year.



We would cut the grass 1 time a year along country roads, instead of 2 times a year.



We would still cut the grass when and where necessary to keep our roads safe for all residents and road users.



Our idea could save us £100,000 next year.

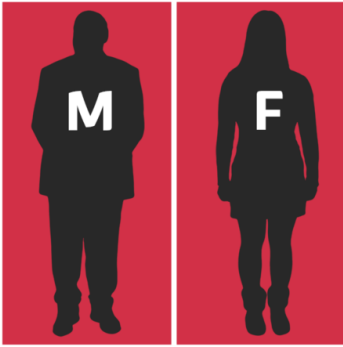
