Children's centres help families by running play sessions and giving them information.



Last year we asked what you thought about our idea to look at what children's centres do so that we could save money.



We have now looked at children's centres to find out if they work in the right ways for families.



We want to find out what you think of our idea for a new Early Childhood and Family Service to help children and families.



Our new service would help communities and parents to run their own local activities and groups.



Our new service would give information and advice for all parents online.



Our new service would offer support groups for some families who need extra help.




Our new service would offer one-to-one support for some families who need extra help.

# If our idea went ahead some things would change



Some parents and carers may have to pay for some of the activities that are currently free.



Some families might have to go to different buildings to get services.



Some families would get services in their own homes.



Some families would go to a support group in a local place, like a village hall, school or library.



There would be more information, advice and help online. This would all be in the same place so that it would be easy to find.



We think we that we would need seven buildings to run the new service. We think these buildings should be:

- City and Eaton Children's Centre
- Drayton and Taverham Children's Centre
- St Clements Children's Centre
- Attleborough Children's Centre
- Long Stratton Children's Centre
- Seagulls Children's Centre
- Holt Children's Centre



We would need to find ways that local communities could use the other 46 children's centre buildings.



If our idea went ahead, things would change from October 2019.
