



# HEMPTON ROUNABOUT CONSULTATION



**17th May to 6th June 2021**

We are proposing to improve the existing B1146 Hempton Green Road / C550 Dereham Road junction at Hempton, near Fakenham, by replacing the current crossroads with a new roundabout, and new and improved paths and crossings for pedestrians.

The aim of the scheme is to help improve safety and reduce congestion at this location which has seen a number of road collisions in recent years. Accident investigations have identified that replacing the existing crossroads with the proposed roundabout will reduce the level of risk at the junction.
