Overview



Recycling centres are there so people in Norfolk can recycle, reuse and dispose of their waste.

Norfolk County Council run 20 recycling centres across the county. This survey is about our plans to build a new centre in **Wymondham** .



Norfolk County Council want to move the current Recycling Centre in Wymondham to a new, bigger site. The new site is located on land off the B1172 London Road, so the new location will not be far away from where the current recycling centre is.

Here is a map of where the new site will be





Norfolk County Council want a new site that makes reuse and recycling easy for residents and improves how much waste is reused or recycled in Norfolk.



We want Wymondham Recycling Centre to become larger, so more people are able to use it And for the site to become more modern. For example, the new site will have step free access.



We are asking people what they think about our plans for the new recycling centre. We want to make sure we've listened to everyone before we get permission for the site to be built. We would also like some information about how you might use the site, to help us make sure it meets your needs.



If we get permission to build this new site, we hope to start building construction in autumn 2023 and then **open the new site in autumn 2024.**

Before we build the site, we will make sure that



The effect of road traffic around the site will be considered.



We will look at what the site will do to the local area in terms of views and how wildlife such as plants and animals will be affected.



We will write a report about how the site might flood, and what we will do to stop flooding.



The new site will be open the same time as the current site is open 9am to 5pm (1 April – 30 September) and 9am to 4pm (1 October – 31 March).



We will keep the site clean and move any waste off the site quickly, so it does not smell. We will also make sure the site is not too noisy. The machines we use will be like the ones we use on the current site.



Before opening, we will have to get a special permit from the Environment Agency and follow rules on what we do with the waste and to make sure our site is safe, secure and does not harm the environment.

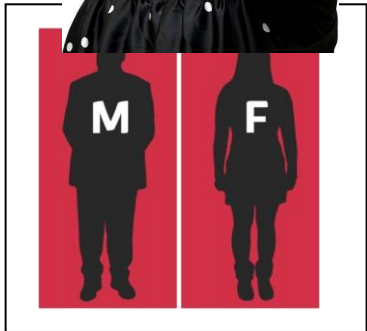

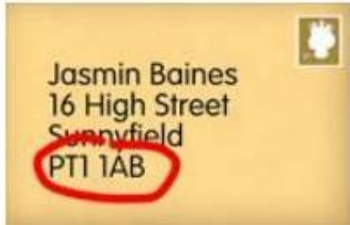
