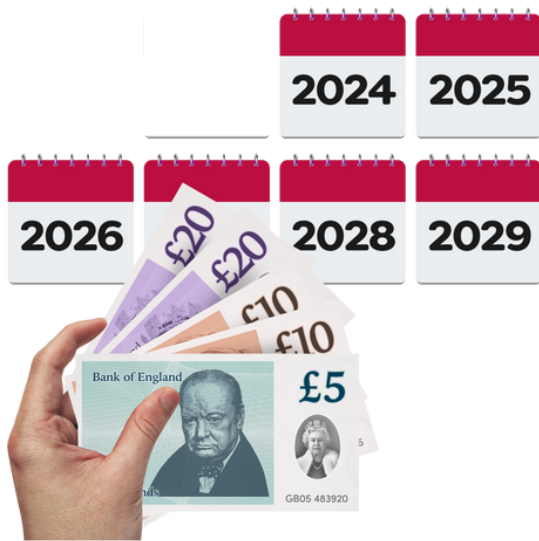
Norfolk County Council have been speaking to the government about getting more money and powers.



When regions in the UK are given more say over what happens in their area by the government, it is called **Devolution.**



Norfolk County Council have agreed a deal with the government, but it can only happen once we've heard what the people of Norfolk think of it.



Under the County Deal, Norfolk would be able to have more control over things like transport, jobs and houses.

Under the deal, Norfolk County Council would get £20 million from the government every year for 30 years.

Lots of other places in the UK have agreed deals like this, and agreeing a deal can sometimes lead to even more money in the future.



If the deal is agreed, it would mean from 2024 that Norfolk would:



Be able to target how money is spent so it helps people in Norfolk.



Helping businesses have more of a voice and a say in decision making in Norfolk. Hopefully this will lead to more businesses opening in Norfolk and more jobs coming to the area.



Invest more in the skills we need, as Norfolk County Council will be in charge of the adult education budget.



Having more power over where to build houses and sites for employment.



Make Norfolk have a stronger voice nationally, so that we are listened to by the government.



Have a council leader who is directly elected by the public.



Invest money in local transport planning. Bringing together transport budgets.
