THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (ORMESBY ST. MICHAEL AND ROLLESBY) (30 M.P.H. AND 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 1997.

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
- 2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
- 3. The Norfolk County Council (A149 Main Road, Ormesby St. Michael/Rollesby) (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1985 is hereby revoked.
- 4. This Order comes into operation on the 21st day of March 1997, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Ormesby St. Michael and Rollesby) (30 m.p.h. and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1997.
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE 1

In the Parish of Rollesby

30 MPH Speed Limit

(U62085)

FLEGGBURGH ROAD - from its junction with the A149 to a point 230 metres south of its junction

with Heath Road (U69336)

RECTORY CLOSE - for its entire length (cul-de-sac)

HEATH ROAD - from its junction with Fleggburgh Road (U69336) - westwards for a distance of 145 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

In the Parishes of Ormesby St. Michael and Rollesby

See 4634

40 MPH Speed Limit

A149 (Main Road)

from a point 100 metres west of the junction with Fleggburgh Road, Rollesby to a point 170 metres east of the junction with Eelsfoot Road, Ormesby St. Michael, a distance of 1.8 miles.
