THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (GREAT YARMOUTH, VARIOUS ROADS)  
(20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2005

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), having given public notice in accordance with sub-section (2) of that section and having consulted the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 2005 and may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, Various Roads) (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2005.
3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any other Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

- U60901 Anson Road - From a point 67 metres west of its junction with the C630 Southtown Road to its junction with the C618 Stafford Road
- C618 Stafford Road - For its entire length
- U61063 Lichfield Road - For its entire length
- U61075 Wolseley Road - For its entire length
- U61051 Albany Road - For its entire length
- U61060 Gordon Road - For its entire length
- U60932/U62161 Tamworth Lane - For its entire length
- U62154 Framlingham Close - For its entire length

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 2003 and shall be made by the Honk County Council (Great Yarmouth, Various Roads) (2003 No. 1) (Special Limit) Order 2003.
3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any other Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order that provision of the Order shall prevail.
