THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (FORNCETT)

(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2004

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4), and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
- 2. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-
 - "The Norfolk County Council (Forncett)(30 m.p.h. and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1996" Schedule 2 in its entirety.
- 3. This Order comes into operation on the 24th day of September 2004 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Forncett)(30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2004.
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Forncett

30 m.p.h. Speed Limit

C344 Aslacton Road

From its junction with the U76170 Wash Lane northwards to a point 55 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the U76096 Cheyneys Lane

C346 Mill Lane

- From its junction with the C344 Aslacton Road westwards for its entire length

C346 Long Stratton Road

 From its junction with the C346 Mill Lane and the U76009 Gilderswood northwards for a distance of 120 metres C345 Station Road

- From its junction with the C344 Aslacton Road eastwards for a distance of 85 metres
