THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (MARSHLAND ST. JAMES/TERRINGTON ST. JOHN)
(40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 1994

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
2. This Order comes into operation on the 20th day of May 1994, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Marshland St. James/Terrington St. John) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1994.
3. Insofar as any provision of This Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE 1

In the Parish of Marshland St. James

- C13 Smeeth Road: from a point 7 metres north-east of the junction centre line of Long Lots Drove, north-east to the Parish boundary at Smeeth Lode Drain, a distance of approximately 3375 metres.
- Walton Road:- from a point 320 metres north-west of Smeeth Road centre line to a point 240 metres south-east of Smeeth Road centre line.
- Trinity Road:- from junction Smeeth Road north-west for a distance of 360 metres.
- Bonnetts Lane:- from junction Smeeth Road south-east for a distance of 150 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

In the Parish of Terrington St. John

- C13 School Road:- from the Parish boundary at Smeeth Lode Drain north-east for a distance of 450 metres.
