

The Norfolk County Council
(Walpole, Walpole Cross Keys and Terrington St Clement, Market Lane)
(40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2023


The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Walpole. Walpole Cross Keys and Terrington St Clement, Market Lane) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2023 and shall come into effect on the 20th day of March 2023.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the C22 Market Lane from the mid-point of its junction with the A17 Terrington St. Clement Bypass southwards and westwards for 2723 metres.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
