

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(MARSHLAND ST JAMES AND TERRINGTON ST JOHN,
WALTON ROAD/SCHOOL ROAD)
(40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) AMENDMENT ORDER 2018**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Marshland St James and Terrington St John, School Road) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Amendment Order 2017 and shall come into effect on the 29th day of January 2018.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the C3 Walton Road/School Road from its junction with U21131 Gooses Lane south-eastwards for a distance of 600 metres in the Parish of Marshland St James at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
3. The Norfolk County Council (Marshland St. James/Terrington St. James) 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits Order 1994 is amended as specified in Article 4 of this Order.
4. In Schedule 1 for the Parish of Marshland St. James the reference to Walton Road is deleted.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, the provision of this Order shall prevail.
