

The Norfolk County Council
(Caister-on-Sea and Ormesby St Margaret with Scratby, Jack Chase Way and
Ormesby Road)
(40mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2025

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Caister-on-Sea and Ormesby St Margaret with Scratby, Jack Chase Way and Ormesby Road) (40mph Speed Limit) Consolidation and Variation Order 2025 and shall come into effect on the 19th day of December 2025.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The Norfolk County Council (Caister-on-Sea, Norwich Road, Ormesby Road and Jack Chase Way) (30 m.p.h. and 40 m.p.h. mph Speed Limits and 20 m.p.h. Zone) Order 2018 is revoked.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

C643 Jack Chase Way	From its junction with the C591 Yarmouth Road south westwards for 1868 metres.
C484 Ormesby Road	From its junction with the C643 Jack Chase Way south eastwards for 460 metres.
