

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(CASTLE ACRE/NEWTON BY CASTLE ACRE, NEWTON MILL BRIDGE
(TF81101), MILL COMMON AND ST JAMES ROAD)
(2.0 METRE (6'6")) WIDTH RESTRICTION) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2023**

The Norfolk County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 9, 10 and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the Act) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Castle Acre/Newton By Castle Acre, Newton Mill Bridge (TF81101), Mill Common and St James Road) (2.0 Metre (6'6")) Width Restriction) Experimental Order 2023 and shall come into operation for all purposes on the 8th day of May 2023.
2. This Order shall remain in force for a period of 18 months.
3. Modifications

The person authorised to make modifications is to be the Executive Director of Community and Environmental Services or a person authorised by him.
4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, no person shall cause a vehicle with a width greater than 2.0 metres (6'6") to proceed along the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the length of the road specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (c) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.
6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 3 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parishes of Castle Acre and Newton by Castle Acre

2.0 metre (6'6") Width Restriction

U33068 Mill Common	-	From its junction with the A1065 northwards and north-westwards to its junction with the U22068 St James Road.
U22068 St James Road (Western arm)	-	From its junction with the U33068 Mill Common westwards for its entire length.
U22068 St James Road (Eastern arm)	-	From its junction with the U33068 Mill Common northwards for its entire length.
U22067 St James Road	-	From a point 1180 metres east of its junction with the C62 Rougham Road north-eastwards for its entire length.
