

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(SOUTH WOOTTON, GRIMSTON ROAD)
(40 M.P.H AND 50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2005

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 50 m.p.h.
3. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The Norfolk County Council (A148 Grimston Road, South Wootton) (40 and 50 m.p.h. Speed limits) Order 1994" - in its entirety.
4. This Order comes into operation on the 25th day of March 2005, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (South Wootton, Grimston Road) (40 m.p.h. and 50 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 2005.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE 1

In the Parish of South Wootton

40 m.p.h. Speed Limit

- A148 Grimston Road - From a point 247 metres east of the centreline of its junction with the C76 Castle Rising Road eastwards to a point 675 metres east of the centreline of its junction with the U22122 Sandy Lane.

SCHEDULE 2

In the Parish of South Wootton

50 m.p.h. Speed Limit

A148 Grimston Road - From a point 675 metres east of the centreline of its junction with the U22122 Sandy Lane eastwards to its junction with the A149 Queen Elizabeth Way at Knights Hill Roundabout.
