


THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(LITTLE PLUMSTEAD, ACCESS ROAD TO NEW SCHOOL)
(20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT ZONE) ORDER 2012

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), having given public notice in accordance with sub-section (2) of that section and having consulted the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the access road to the new school in the parish of Little Plumstead at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces)(Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 17th day of August 2012 and may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Little Plumstead, Access Road to New School)(20 m.p.h. Speed Limit Zone) Order 2012.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
