THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (MATTISHALL, YAXHAM ROAD, STONE ROAD AND OLD HALL ROAD) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2009

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
- 2. This Order comes into operation on the 20th day of March 2009, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Mattishall, Yaxham Road, Stone and Old Hall Road) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2009.
- 3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Mattishall

40 m.p.h. Speed Limit

C200 Yaxham Road

 From a point 75 metres east of its junction with the U35139 Old Hall Road north-westwards to a point for 280 metres north-west of its junction with the C211A Stone Road.

C211A Stone Road

 From its junction with the C200 Yaxham Road northwards for a distance of 12 metres.

U35139 Old Hall Road

- From its junction with the C200 Yaxham Road southwards for a distance of 15 metres.
