THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (NARBOROUGH)

(30 M.P.H. AND 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 1996

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
- 2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
- 3. The Trunk Roads (40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) (No. 24) Order 1968 is hereby revoked.
- 4. This Order comes into operation on the 22nd day of March, 1996, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Narborough) (30 m.p.h. and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1996.
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE 1

In the Parish of Narborough

30 m.p.h. Speed Limit

Main Road - from a point 175 metres north of the centre line of the junction with Pentney Road, south and south-east to a point 20 metres

south-east of the centre line of the junction with Narford Road.

Marham Road - from the junction with Main Road/Swaffham Road south to a

point 200 metres south of the centre line of the junction with

Westfields.

Pentney Road - from its junction with Main Road west for a distance of 100

metres.

Dennys Walk - from its junction with Marham Road west to its junction with

Old Vicarage Park.

Old Vicarage Park

Westfields - entire estate

Eastfields

Mead Close for its entire length

Blacksmith Close - for its entire length

SCHEDULE 2

40 m.p.h. Speed Limit

Swaffham Road

from a point 20 metres south-east of the centre line of the junction with Narford Road south-eastwards for a distance of 645 metres.
