

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(SALHOUSE, NORWICH ROAD/HONEYCOMBE LANE)

(40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2002

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
2. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The Norfolk County Council (Salhouse and Rackheath) (30 m.p.h. and 50 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1996" - insofar as it refers to the length of Norwich Road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order comes into operation on the 8th day of February 2002, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Salhouse, Norwich Road/ Honeycombe Lane) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2002.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Salhouse

40 m.p.h. Speed Limit

- C283/B1140 Norwich Road - From a point 200 metres west of the centreline of its junction with Honeycombe Lane eastwards to a point 15 metres east of the centreline of its junction with Thieves Lane
- C284 Honeycombe Lane - From its junction with Norwich Road southwards for a distance of 115 metres
