

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (GREAT YARMOUTH,
NORTH DRIVE, MARINE PARADE AND SOUTH BEACH PARADE)
(ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES)
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2012**

The Norfolk County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of their powers under Sections 32(1), 35(A), and 45 to 47, and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as “the 2004 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of March 2012, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, North Drive, Marine Parade and South Beach Parade) (On-Street Parking Places and Pay and Display Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2012.

PART 1

GENERAL

2. Interpretation

Any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

“Agent” means any period in which there is in force an Agreement under the Local Government Act 2000 between Norfolk County Council and Great Yarmouth Borough Council, The Borough Council of King’s Lynn and West Norfolk and South Norfolk District Council to administer functions conferred by that Agreement on the Council’s behalf, failing which it shall mean Norfolk County Council;

“Bus” has the same meaning as in Regulation 22(2) of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

“Charging Hours” means the periods specified in Column 5 of Schedule 1 to this Order in respect of which a charge is made as specified in Article 3;

“Coastguard vehicle” means a vehicle being used and authorised to wait by the Coastguard;

“Council” means The Norfolk County Council or its Agent;

“Civil Enforcement Officer” has the same meaning as in section 76 of the 2004 Act;

“Cycle” has the same meaning as in section 192 of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

“Cycle Parking Place” means any part of a highway authorised by this Order to be used as a Parking Place for a Cycle;

"Driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place, or the person deemed to be the driver under the terms of this Order;

"Disabled Parking Place" means an area of the Parking Place indicated as such as an area where a Disabled Person's Vehicle displaying a Disabled' Persons Badge and Parking Disc, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, may be stationed;

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Person's (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000; and

"Parking Disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No 3551 : 1970), but coloured blue and capable of showing the quarter hours period during which a period of waiting begins; and

for the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a Disabled Person's badge in the relevant position, when

- (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen
 - (i) the badge is exhibited facing forwards of the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
 - (ii) the parking disc is exhibited in the relevant position with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen, and
- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge or disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the side of the vehicle.

"Enforcement Authority" means the Council or its Agent;

"Excursion or tour" has the same meaning as in section 137(1) of the Transport Act 1985(a);

"General Regulations 2007" shall mean The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;

"Heavy Commercial Vehicle" and "HGV" have the same meaning as in section 138 of the Act;

"Motor Car", "Motor Cycle" and "Invalid Carriage" shall have the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act;

"Motor Cycle Parking Place" means an area of the Parking Place indicated as such as an area where a Motor Cycle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, may be stationed;

“Pay and Display Parking Place” means the length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order indicated by markings on the surface as an area where a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Articles 3 – 5 and 14 of this Order may be stationed;

"Parking Bay" means an area of a Parking Place or Pay and Display Parking Place indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place as an area where a vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, may be stationed;

“Parking Charge” means the sum of money specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1 to this Order;

"Penalty Charge" has the same meaning as in section 2 of the General Regulations 2007;

“Penalty Charge Notice” has the same meaning as in section 8 of the General Regulations 2007;

“Parking Permit” means a concessionary permit as specified in Articles 7, 8 and 9 of this Order;

"Parking Place" means the length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedules 2-4 to this Order indicated by markings on the surface as an area where a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order may be stationed;

“Parking Ticket” means a ticket supplied by a Ticket Machine which displays the date and time the vehicle is permitted to park in the Pay and Display Parking Place;

“Private Service Vehicle” means a Bus in use for part of an excursion or tour;

"Public Service Vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

“Rider” in relation to a cycle or a Motor Cycle, means the person riding the cycle at the time it was left in a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place;

"Ticket Machine" means the apparatus provided at the Pay and Display Parking Place, being an apparatus for issuing parking tickets indicating the payment of the Parking Charge and the date and time at which the Parking Charge was paid;

“Trailer” has the same meaning as in section 3 of The Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986.

PART 2

DESIGNATION, CHARGES AND PENALTY CHARGES

Classes and position of vehicles

3. The lengths of carriageway specified in column 1 of the Schedules to this Order are authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as Pay and Display Parking Places and Parking Places for such classes of vehicles, in such positions and on such days and during such hours, and where required, at such scale of charges as are specified in relation to that section of road in columns 2-6 of the said Schedule.

4. Where in the Schedules to this Order a Pay and Display Parking Place and Parking Place is described, or where a Parking Bay is designated by surface or other markings, as available for vehicles of a specified class, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait unless it is of the specified class.
5. The driver or rider of a vehicle shall not:-
 - (i) cause or permit a vehicle to be left: in a Parking Bay in any position other than wholly within a Parking Bay; nor
 - (ii) cause or permit a vehicle to be left in such a position as to prevent the driving away of any vehicle already standing in a Parking Bay or in such a position as to cause an obstruction to other vehicles;
 - (iii) cause or permit a vehicle to be left in a Parking Bay so unreasonably as to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons.
 - (iv) when for preventing obstruction of the streets, or danger or for any other lawful purpose, the Council by Order has closed that Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place and exhibited notice of such closure on or near that Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place.
6. Nothing in this Order shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstruction of the streets, by Order, on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination or where the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close any Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place and exhibit such Notices to that effect. Failure to observe such notices shall be a contravention of this Order.

Permits

7. The driver of a vehicle, being a resident of a property numbered 1-50 South Beach Parade may, subject to the Council's discretion, apply to the Council for a South Beach Parade Parking Permit valid in respect of a specified vehicle for a period of twelve months. A South Beach Parade Parking Permit may be used to allow that specified vehicle to wait at any time along the west side of the U62487 South Beach Parade (the crescent), in accordance with all other provisions of this Order.
8. The driver of a vehicle, being a resident of a property numbered 16-34 North Drive may, subject to the Council's discretion, apply to the Council for a North Drive Parking Permit valid in respect of a specified vehicle for a period of twelve months. A North Drive Parking Permit may be used to allow that specified vehicle to wait at any time along the west side of the C628 North Drive from its junction with the U60176 Sandown Road to its junction with the U60165 Marine Crescent, in accordance with all other provisions of this Order.
9. A resident of a property numbered 1-50 South Beach Parade or a property numbered 16-34 North Drive may, subject to the Council's discretion, apply to the Council for a Parking Permit to be valid for an unspecified vehicle for use by a Carer or Health Worker whilst performing their duties at that property.
10. The issue of any Parking Permit is at the discretion of the Council. The Council may limit the number of issue of any type of Parking Permit and shall not be obliged to issue any Parking Permit if doing so would exceed the permitted maximum number of Parking Permits for that Parking Place.

11. The driver of a vehicle using a Pay and Display Parking Place in accordance with Articles 7, 8 and 9 of this Order; and
- (i) which vehicle possesses a windscreen shall display the Parking Permit within the vehicle either by attaching it firmly to the front windscreen or by placing it on the dashboard of the vehicle;
 - (ii) which vehicle does not possess a windscreen shall display the Parking Permit in a conspicuous position,
- so that the particulars appropriate to the provisions of that Parking Permit are shown and clearly visible from outside the vehicle during the entire period the vehicle is waiting in that parking place. A permit which is not displayed in accordance with this clause is not valid.
12. Where a Parking Permit has been used contrary to the conditions of use of the Parking Permit or is otherwise in breach of the provisions of this Order the Council may declare that Parking Permit invalid.
13. A Parking Permit issued in accordance with Articles 7 and 8 of this Order shall not be valid for any vehicle other than the vehicle for which it was issued (whether or not that other vehicle is owned or is under the control of the driver).

Payment and Display of Ticket

- 14(1). The driver of a vehicle using a Pay and Display Parking Place shall, on leaving the vehicle wholly in that parking place, pay the appropriate Parking Charge in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 14(2). The rider of a Motor Cycle using a Parking Place:-
- (i) which is a designated Motor Cycle Parking Place may leave that Motor Cycle wholly within that designated Motor Cycle Parking Place without payment of a Parking Charge;
 - (ii) must, if parked within a Pay and Display Parking Place, pay the appropriate Parking Charge as specified in Article 14(1) of this Order.
- 14(3). The Parking Charge shall be payable by the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins or payment card into an apparatus or device provided being an apparatus or device known as a ticket machine. The driver or rider having paid the Parking Charge will be issued with a Parking Ticket via the ticket machine.
- 14(4). The driver of a vehicle using a Pay and Display Parking Place in accordance with Articles 14(1), 14(2)(ii) and 14(3) of this Order; and
- (i) which vehicle possesses a windscreen shall display the Parking Ticket issued by a ticket machine, within the vehicle either by attaching it firmly to the front windscreen or by placing it on the dashboard of the vehicle;
 - (ii) which vehicle does not possess a windscreen shall display the Parking Ticket issued by a ticket machine in a conspicuous position,

so that the payment in accordance with the scale of charges appropriate to the Pay and Display Parking Place as specified in the Schedules to this Order, the day, date and time of issue and all other particulars shown are clearly visible from outside the vehicle during the entire period the vehicle is waiting in that parking place. A Parking Ticket which is not displayed in accordance with this clause is not valid.

- 14(5). Any Parking Ticket issued on payment of the Parking Charge referred to in Article 14(1) of this Order is not transferable and shall not be valid for any vehicle (whether or not that other vehicle is owned or is under the control of the driver) other than that for which it was originally purchased.

Disabled Person's Parking

15. Nothing in this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and Parking Disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths of road or on the side of road referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding the time specified in the current regulations.
16. The driver of a vehicle displaying a Disabled Person's Badge (subject to compliance with all other provisions of this Order) may park that vehicle in a designated Disabled Parking Place provided that:
- (a) the driver of the vehicle is a disabled person to whom the badge was issued in respect of that vehicle; or
 - (b) the vehicle is being used for the carriage of a disabled person to whom the badge was issued; or
 - (c) the vehicle is one being used for the carriage of disabled persons by an institution to whom the badge was issued in respect of that vehicle; and
 - (d) the time during which the vehicle will be parked in the said parking bay is indicated on the parking disc provided by local authority for that purpose.

Penalty Charge and Penalty Charge Notice

17. Where a vehicle is left waiting in a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place in contravention of this Order a Penalty Charge shall become payable. A Penalty Charge Notice to that effect will be attached to the vehicle or handed to the driver by a Civil Enforcement Officer, in accordance with Article 20 of this Order.
18. A Penalty Charge shall be payable to the Enforcement Authority.
19. In the event of payment of the Penalty Charge being received by the Enforcement Authority within 14 days of the day in which it was incurred the amount of Penalty Charge will be discounted in accordance with Regulation 5 of the General Regulations 2007.

20. A Penalty Charge Notice referred to in Article 17 and issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer shall include the following particulars:
- (a) the Enforcement Authority,
 - (b) the Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place at which the contravention occurred,
 - (c) the registration mark or when the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the registration mark of that trade licence,
 - (d) the date and time at which the Penalty Charge was seen to be payable,
 - (e) the grounds on which the Civil Enforcement Officer serving the Penalty Charge Notice believes that a Penalty Charge is payable,
 - (f) the amount of the Penalty Charge,
 - (g) the manner in which and time within which the Penalty Charge shall be paid,
 - (h) a statement that a reduced charge may be payable if payment is made within fourteen days of the Penalty Charge Notice being incurred,
 - (i) a statement to the effect that if the Penalty Charge is not paid before the end of the period of 28 days a Notice to Owner may be served by the Enforcement Authority on the owner of the vehicle.
- 21(1). Where a driver has left a vehicle in a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place in contravention of this Order and a Penalty Charge Notice could not be issued as specified in Article 17 of this Order a Penalty Charge Notice may be issued by post by the Enforcement Authority in accordance with section 10 of the General Regulations 2007.
- 22(2). Any Penalty Charge Notice issued in accordance with Article 21(1) of this Order shall, in addition to the particulars specified in Article 20(a), (b), (c), (e) and (f) of this Order, include the particulars specified in paragraph 2 of the Schedule to the General Regulations 2007.
23. The driver of a vehicle in respect of which a Penalty Charge Notice has been incurred shall pay the Penalty Charge or provide proof of payment of the Penalty Charge to the Enforcement Authority as detailed on the reverse of the notice within 28 days of the date on which the Penalty Charge Notice is served. If payment is received within a period of 14 days beginning with the date on which the Penalty Charge Notice is served the amount of the penalty Charge shall be reduced by 50% (provided that if the fourteenth day falls upon a day on which the Enforcement Authority's offices are closed the period within which payment of the said charge is due shall be extended to 1.00 p.m. on the next full day on which the office is open).
24. Where the driver of a vehicle fails to pay the Penalty Charge as specified in Article 23 of this Order the Enforcement Authority may follow the procedures set out in the General Regulations 2007 to recover the Penalty Charge.

25. The driver of a vehicle who desires to make representation to or appeal against a Penalty Charge Notice issued to him may make representation or appeal to the Enforcement Authority pursuant to the procedures set out in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) Representations and Appeals Regulations 2007.
26. Where a Penalty Charge Notice has been attached to a vehicle as a result of the provisions of Article 17 no person, not being the driver of the vehicle or a person duly authorised by the Council, shall remove that Notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

PART 3

USE OF PARKING PLACES

27. The rider of a cycle using a Cycle Parking Place shall dismount the cycle prior to mounting the footway kerb and leave the cycle in the correct position in the Cycle Parking Place. The rider shall not remount the cycle except when rejoining the main carriageway upon departing from the Cycle Parking Place.
28. The driver or rider of a vehicle using a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in that parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in that parking place, or to depart from that parking place.
29. Except with the authority of the Council or person authorised on behalf of the Council, no person shall use a vehicle, whilst it is in a Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near that parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
30. Except with the authority of the Council or person authorised on behalf of the Council, no person shall distribute, affix or cause to be affixed any advertising material to any vehicle left in a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place.
31. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a vehicle is left in a Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place in contravention of any of the provisions of Articles 3,4, 5 and 6 of this Order, or it is necessary to meet the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised on behalf of the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place, or may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions or meet the requirements of the emergency.
32. Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 31 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as that person may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as that person may think necessary to enable that person to remove or alter its position.

33. When a person authorised by the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place by virtue of Articles 31 and 32 of this Order, that person shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of that vehicle.
34. Where a vehicle has been removed in accordance with Articles 31, 32, and 33 of this Order the charges as specified in section 3 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges)(England) Order 2007 shall become payable.
35. The driver of a motor vehicle using the parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place.
36. No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council, drive any vehicle in a Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in that parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from that parking place.
37. No person shall, in a Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place, wantonly shout or otherwise make a loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of that parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.
38. No person shall, in a Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place, use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.
39. No person shall, except with the authority of the Council use a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place or any vehicle left in a parking place:
 - (a) for sleeping or camping purposes,
 - (b) for eating or cooking purposes,
 - (c) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from that parking place,
 - (d) for skateboarding, roller skating or wheeled activities which may be hazardous to other traffic,
 - (e) for the instruction of pupils whilst undertaking driving lessons;
 - (f) to play or take part in any game.

40. In a Pay and Display Parking Place or a Parking Place no person shall:
- (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure except with the authority of the Council or person authorised on behalf of the Council; or
 - (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire.
41. No person shall proceed to enter a Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place whilst towing any vehicle except;
- (a) where the towed vehicle is required in order that a vehicle may be removed in accordance with Articles 31, 32 and 33 of this Order;
 - (b) where the towed vehicle is carrying equipment required by the driver for ground maintenance at that parking place;
 - (c) where the towed vehicle is required for remedial works at or to that parking place by statutory utilities staff; or
 - (d) where permission has been granted by the Council.
42. In the Pay and Display Parking Place or Parking Place no person shall leave stationed or cause or permit to be stationed a vehicle which has a maximum gross vehicle weight exceeding 2 tonnes except upon the direction or with the permission of the Council or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
43. The following Orders will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-
- “The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, Marine Parade/South Beach Parade) (Street Parking Places) Order 2001” – in its entirety;
- “The Norfolk County Council (Great Yarmouth, Marine Parade)(Street Parking Places for Disabled Persons Vehicles) Order 2008” – in its entirety;

44. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
