

**THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(NORWICH, A1242 THORPE ROAD) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021.**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), having given public notice in accordance with sub-section (2) of that section and having consulted the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Norwich, A1242 Thorpe Road) (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2021 and shall come into effect on the xxxxx day of 2021.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour along the A1242 Thorpe Road from a point 5 metres west of the centre line of its junction with the U42625 Lower Clarence Road to its junction with the A147 Riverside Road/A147 Riverside in the City of Norwich.
3. The length of carriageway specified in Article 2 above will cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
