

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(UPWELL, BLUNT'S ORCHARD DRIVE AND ORCHARD GARDENS)
(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84, 122 and 122A and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Upwell, Blunt's Orchard Drive and Orchard Gardens) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2024 and shall come into effect on the 24th June 2024.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

20mph Speed Limit

U23789/10 Blunt's Orchard Drive	-	From the mid-point of its junction with C18/10 St Peters Road Southwards for its entirety (115 metres).
U23787/10 Orchard Gardens	-	From the mid-point of its junction with U23789/10 Blunt's Orchard Drive, Eastwards for its entirety (76 metres).
U23787/20 Orchard Gardens	-	From the mid-point of its junction with U23787/10 Orchard Gardens Northwards for its entirety (15 metres).
U23787/20 Orchard Gardens	-	From the mid-point of its junction with U23787/10 Orchard Gardens Southwards for its entirety (15 metres).
