THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (NORTH LOPHAM)

(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1998

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 82(2) and 83(2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
- 2. The following Order is hereby revoked:

The Norfolk County Council (Miscellaneous) (40 m.p.h. and 50 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Consolidation Order 1993 insofar as it relates to North Lopham.

- 3. This Order comes into operation on the 3rd day of April 1998, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (North Lopham) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1998.
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of North Lopham

30 m.p.h. Speed Limit

C570 Kenninghall Road,
The Street and Church Road

- from a point 100 metres north of its junction with Hargham Road to a point 100 metres south of its junction with the unclassified road 33185 to Great Common.

Hargham Road - from its junction with C870 The Street northwest for a distance of 120 metres.

Kings Head Lane - from its junction with C870 The Street west for a distance of 280 metres.

Tanns Lane - from its junction with C870 The Street east and southwest for a distance of 740 metres.

Cherry Tree Close - entire length.
