THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (NORTH RUNCTON)

(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1996

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) and part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
- 2. This Order comes into operation on the 22nd day of March 1996, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (North Runcton) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1996.
- 3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of North Runcton

C62 Rectory Lane from its junction New Road westwards for a distance of 500 metres. C62 New Road from the centre line of its junction with Rectory Lane north to a point 130 metres southwest of its junction with the A47. u/c 22025 New Road from the centre line of its junction with Rectory Lane south and southwest over the common to a point 420 metres southwest of the centre line of the Chequers Lane junction. from its junction with u/c 22025 west for a distance of u/c 22024 Chequers Lane 350 metres. Cedar Grove entire length Hall Drive entire length.
