

**Norfolk County Council**  
**(Norwich, Exchange Street Area)(Traffic Management)**  
**Experimental Traffic Regulation Order Modification 2022**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of powers under sections 9 and 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following modifications:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Exchange Street Area) (Traffic Management) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order Modification 2022 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November 2022 and shall remain in force until 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2023.
2. The Norfolk County Council's Executive Director Community and Environmental Services, or a person authorised by him, is empowered to modify or suspend the operation of the Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Exchange Street Area) (Traffic Management) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2022 dated 19<sup>th</sup> May 2022 (hereinafter referred to as the "Experimental Order") to the extent permitted by section 10 of the Act as set out in Articles 3 to 7 in this Order.
3. Article 5 (i) of the Experimental Order is deleted and the reference to 'Imposing One-way restrictions is removed.
4. Article 6 of the Experimental order is amended to read as follows:-  
  
'No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or an authorised officer of the Council cause or permit any vehicle, other than a cycle or emergency vehicle, to proceed in the U41930 Upper Goat Lane in any direction other than north to south.
5. 'Article 7 of the Experimental Order is deleted in its entirety.
6. Article 9 of the Experimental Order is amended to read as follows:-  
  
'No person shall cause any vehicle, other than a cycle or emergency vehicle on emergency business, to proceed in a westerly direction along the C854 Charing Cross, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or cause that vehicle to proceed beyond the junction with the C854 St Benedict's Street.
7. Article 10 of the Experimental Order is deleted in its entirety.
