# THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (CRINGLEFORD, NEWMARKET ROAD)

# (50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2005

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 50 m.p.h.
- 2. This Order comes into operation on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 2005, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Cringleford, Newmarket Road) (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2005.
- Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

#### SCHEDULE

## In the Parish of Cringleford

### 50 m.p.h. Speed Limit

A11 Newmarket Road North-east bound carriageway

 From its eastern junction with the A11 Roundhouse roundabout (at present under construction) northeastwards to a point 783 metres south-west of its junction with Unthank Road

A11 Newmarket Road South-west bound carriageway

 From its eastern junction with the A11 Roundhouse roundabout (at present under construction) northeastwards to a point 187 metres south-west of its junction with Unthank Road

C821 Newmarket Road

 From a point 45 metres west of the centreline of its junction with the C184 Keswick Road to its junction with the south-west bound carriageway of the A11 Newmarket Road
