THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (SWAFFHAM, VARIOUS ROADS) (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and 122, 122A and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Swaffham, Various Roads) (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2018 and shall come into effect on the 29th day of May 2018.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, the provision of this Order shall prevail.
