

**The Norfolk County Council  
(Old Hunstanton, Various Roads)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2025**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(1), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Old Hunstanton, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2025 and shall come into effect on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 2025.

2. In this Order –

Any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them.

“Civil Enforcement Officer” has the same meaning as in section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 and a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, if

- (a) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle: or
  - (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle
- so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle

“General Directions” means The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"Parking Disc" means a device which:

- (a) is 125 millimetres square and coloured blue, if issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2000 or orange, if issued before that date;
- (b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid; and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting has begun;

and a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a Parking Disc in the relevant position, if:

- (d) the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
- (e) where the vehicle does not have a dashboard or fascia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

so that when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle

“The Regulations” means The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000, and any statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof;

3. Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait
  - (i) at any time from Good Friday to 30<sup>th</sup> September along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order; and
  - (ii) on Monday to Sunday between 8am and 6pm from Good Friday to 30<sup>th</sup> September along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order or on the side of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
  - (a) goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or
  - (b) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;

provided these are not excluded by any road markings or signs pursuant to the General Directions

5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order or on the side of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
  - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or side of roads; or
  - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning in, or near, the said lengths of road or side of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Digital Economy Act 2017 lawfully kept installed in any position.
  - (v) the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011;
  - (vi) where the vehicle is owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles, when in use as part of a funeral cortege
  - (vii) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes
  - (viii) in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (ix) to wait when the person in control of the vehicle is required to stop by law, or is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstance outside their control
6. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit any vehicle which lawfully displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a Parking Disc to wait along the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order or on the side of roads referred to therein for a period not exceeding the time specified in The Regulations.
7. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
8. The Norfolk County Council (Old Hunstanton, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2012 will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order.

Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time – Good Friday To 30<sup>th</sup> September

U22149 Church Road Both Sides	-	From the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road southwards for a distance of 22 metres
A149 Cromer Road East side	-	From its junction with the U20001 Golf Course Road southwards for a distance of 28 metres
A149 Cromer Road West side	-	From its junction with the U20001 Golf Course Road southwards for a distance of 26 metres

U20001 Golf Course Road	-	From its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road/Cromer Road northwards to its junction with the U20002 Wodehouse Road
U20005 Hamilton Road Both Sides	-	From the centreline of its junction with the A20002 Wodehouse Road southwards for a distance of 15 metres
U20005 Hamilton Road East Side	-	From the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 17 metres
U20005 Hamilton Road West Side	-	From the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 25 metres
U20005 Hamilton Road West Side	-	From a point 167 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 28 metres
U20007 Hamon Close South east side	-	From the centreline of its junction with the U20006 Sea Lane south-westwards for a distance of 12 metres
U20007 Hamon Close North west side	-	From the centreline of its junction with the U20006 Sea Lane south-westwards for a distance of 9 metres
A149 Old Hunstanton Road Both Sides	-	From its junction with the U20001 Golf Course Road eastwards for a distance of 10 metres
A149 Old Hunstanton Road North Side	-	From a point 244 metres east of its junction with the U20001 Golf Course Road eastwards to a point 78 metres east of the centreline of its junction with U20005 Hamilton Road
A149 Old Hunstanton Road North Side	-	From the centreline of its junction with the U20003 Waterworks Road westwards for a distance of 54 metres and eastwards for a distance of 58 metres
A149 Old Hunstanton Road South Side	-	From a point 241 metres east of its junction with the U20001 Golf Course Road eastwards for a distance of 152 metres
A149 Old Hunstanton Road South Side	-	From the centreline of its junction with the U22149 Church Road westwards for a distance of 79 metres and eastwards for a distance of 19 metres
U20006 Sea Lane Both Sides	-	From the centre line of its junction with the U20002 Wodehouse Road southwards for a distance of 19 metres
U20006 Sea Lane Both Sides	-	From the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 38 metres
U20006 Sea Lane Both Sides	-	From a point 118 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 79 metres
U20003 Waterworks Road Both Sides	-	From the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 10 metres
U20002 Wodehouse Road North Side	-	From its junction with the U20006 Sea Lane eastwards for a distance of 72 metres
U20002 Wodehouse Road South Side	-	From its junction with the U20006 Sea Lane eastwards for a distance of 44 metres

U20002 Wodehouse Road South Side	-	From the centre line of its junction with the U20005 Hamilton Road eastwards for a distance of 13 metres and westwards for a distance of 13 metres

U23369 Ashdale Park Both Sides	-	From the centreline of its junction with the U20002 Wodehouse Road northwards for a distance of 66 metres
U20005 Hamilton Road West Side	-	From a point 25 metres north of the centreline of its junction with A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 142 metres
U20005 Hamilton Road West Side	-	From a point 195 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road to a point 15 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the U20002 Wodehouse Road
U20008 Howard Close Both Sides	-	From the centre point of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road southwards for a distance of 9 metres
A149 Old Hunstanton Road North Side	-	From a point 10 metres east of its junction with the U20001 Golf Course Road eastwards for a distance of 210 metres
A149 Old Hunstanton Road South Side	-	From a point 10 metres east of its junction with the U20001 Golf Course Road eastwards for a distance of 219 metres
U20006 Sea Lane East Side	-	From a point 38 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 80 metres
U20006 Sea Lane East Side	-	From a point 197 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road to a point 19 metres south of the centre line of its junction with U20002 Wodehouse Road
U20006 Sea Lane West Side	-	From a point 38 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 8 metres
U20006 Sea Lane West Side	-	From a point 52 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 66 metres
U20006 Sea Lane West Side	-	From a point 197 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the A149 Old Hunstanton Road northwards for a distance of 44 metres
U23189 Smugglers Close Both sides	-	From the centreline of its junction with the U20003 Waterworks Road westwards for a distance of 34 metres
U20003 Waterworks Road East Side	-	From a point 11 metres south-west of the centre line of its junction with the U20002 Wodehouse Road northwards to the extents of the public highway boundary (284 metres)

U20003 Waterworks Road West Side	-	From the centreline of its junction with the U20002 Wodehouse Road south-westwards for a distance of 11 metres and north-eastwards for a distance of 38 metres
U20003 Waterworks Road West Side	-	From a point 52 metres north-eastwards of the centreline of its junction with the U20002 Wodehouse Road north-eastwards for a distance of 8 metres
U20003 Waterworks Road West Side	-	From a point 72 metres north-eastwards of the centreline of its junction with the U20002 Wodehouse Road northwards to the extents of the public highway boundary (199 metres)
U20002 Wodehouse Road North Side	-	From a point 72 metres east of its junction with the U20006 Sea Lane eastwards to its junction with the U20003 Waterworks Road
U20002 Wodehouse Road South Side	-	From a point 44 metres east of its junction with the U20006 Sea Lane eastwards to a point 13 metres west of the centreline of its junction with U20005 Hamilton Road
U20002 Wodehouse Road South Side	-	From a point 13 metres east of the centreline of its junction with the U20005 Hamilton Road eastwards to its junction with the U20003 Waterworks Road
