

**The Norfolk County Council
(Norwich, A1074 Dereham Road and U41931 Valentine Street)
(Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 2025**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the "Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Norwich, A1074 Dereham Road and U41931 Valentine Street) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 2025 and shall come into effect on the 6th day of October 2025.
2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer (within the meaning of section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004) in uniform cause any vehicle exiting the junction situated at a point 28 metres to a point 23 metres east of the eastern back of highway line of Raglan Street, to turn right onto the westbound carriageway of the A1074 Dereham Road.
3. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer (within the meaning of section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004) in uniform cause any vehicle driving along the U41931 Valentine Street to turn right onto the eastbound carriageway of the A1074 Dereham Road.
4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall prohibit a person to cause or permit any vehicle to make the prohibited right turn where that vehicle is used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
