THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (WEETING WITH BROOMHILL, C873 BRANDON ROAD)

(30 M.P.H. AND 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2003

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
- 2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
- 3. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-
 - "The Norfolk County Council (Weeting with Broomhill) (30 and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit Extensions) Order 1995" Schedule 1 of that Order
- 4. This Order comes into operation on the 21st day of November 2003 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Weeting with Broomhill, C873 Brandon Road)(30 m.p.h. and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 2003.
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE 1

In the Parish of Weeting with Broomhill

30 m.p.h. Speed Limit

C873 Brandon Road - From a point 110 metres north-west of the centreline of its junction with the U33332 All Saints south-eastwards to a point 65 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the U33326 Peppers Close

SCHEDULE 2

In the Parish of Weeting with Broomhill

40 m.p.h. Speed Limit

C873 Brandon Road -

From a point 140 metres north-west of the centreline of its junction with the U33330 Cromwell Road south-eastwards to a point 110 metres north-west of the centreline of its junction with the U33332 All Saints
