The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h.
2. This Order comes into operation on the 15th day of May 1998, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Burnham Overy) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1998.
3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Burnham Overy and Burnham Market

B1155 Overy Road/ Burnham Road - From a point 90 metres northeast of the centreline of U22168 Friar's Lane northeastwards, northwards and eastwards to a point 841 metres east of the centreline of U22171 Mill Road.

In the Parish of Burnham Overy

U22171 Mill Road - from B1155 Burnham Road/Overy Road to its junction with U22172 Mill Road.

U22172 Mill Road - From the centreline of U22171 Mill Road northwards for a distance of 35 metres.
