THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (WATTON AND LITTLE CRESSINGHAM) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) AMENDMENT ORDER 2018

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2)/84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4) and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Watton and Little Cressingham) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Amendment Order 2018 and comes into operation on the 12th day of March 2018.
- 2. The Schedule to The Norfolk County Council (Watton) (30 M.P.H. Speed Limit Extensions) Order 1994 ("the 1994 Order") is amended by the deletion of the length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order and the addition of the length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 3. After Article 3 of the 1994 Order the following Article is inserted: "4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces)(Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations".
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
