The Norfolk County Council (Fakenham, Long Lane) (Prohibition Of Entry) Order 2025

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Fakenham, Long Lane) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 2025 and shall come into operation for all purposes on the 9th day of June 2025.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed along the Long Lane (northbound) from its junction with the A148 roundabout.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in that Article for so long as it may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or side of roads;
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of road or side of roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Digital Economy Act 2017;
 - (iv) the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011;
 - (v) fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (vi) in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (vii) is a pedal cycle being pushed or ridden;
 - (viii) is a perambulator being pushed;
 - (ix) is an Agricultural Motor Vehicle as defined in The Road Vehicles (Authorisation of Special Types) (General) Order 2003 being "a motor vehicle (not being a dual purpose vehicle) which —

- a) is constructed or adapted for use off-road for the purpose of agriculture, horticulture or forestry; and
- b) is primarily used for one or more of those purposes.
- 4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 2 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
