

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(MATTISHALL, CHURCH PLAIN AND MILL STREET)

(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2006

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and 85(2) and (4), and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the C198 Church Plain and Mill Street, in the Parish of Mattishall, from its junctions with the C200 Dereham Road southwards to a point 340 metres south of its junction with the U35013 Thynnes Lane, at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The County Council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads)(No 1) Order 1977" – insofar as it refers to its entry for the C198 Church Plain and Mill Road in the Parish of Mattishall.
3. This Order comes into operation on the 7th day of July 2006 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Mattishall, Church Plain and Mill Street)(30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2006.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in Article 1 of this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
