## The Norfolk County Council (Sprowston, Mousehold Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) <u>Traffic Regulation Amendment Order 2022</u>

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4 and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (Sprowston, Mousehold Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Amendment Order 2022 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August 2022.
- 2. The Norfolk County Council (Sprowston, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2011 (hereinafter referred to as the "2011 Order") is amended by the deletion and addition of the lengths of roads as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

## SCHEDULE In the Town of Sprowston

Delete the following reference from Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order:-

## Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

A1042 Mousehold Lane (North-east side) – From a point 46 metres east of the centreline of its junction with the U57332 Corbet Avenue north-westwards for a distance of 129 metres.

Insert the following reference into Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order:-

## Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

A1042 Mousehold Lane (North-east side) – From a point 176 metres south-east of the centreline of its junction with the U57332 Corbet Avenue north-westwards for a distance of 259 metres.
