

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (DRAYTON, VARIOUS ROADS)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2011

The Norfolk County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

1. Save as provided in Article 2, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in that Article if the vehicle being used:
 - (a) is for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) is in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) is in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (d) is for the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (e) requires access to private property situated along or adjacent to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of November 2011 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Drayton, Various Roads)(Prohibition of Driving) Consolidation Order 2011.
4. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The Norfolk County Council (Various Roads, Drayton)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1995" – in its entirety.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Drayton

Prohibition of Driving

- U57594 Bone Road - From its junction with the U57461 Carter Road to its junction with the U57576 George Drive
- U57461 Carter Road - From its junction with the C282 Hall Lane southwards and south-westwards to its junction with the A1067 Drayton High Road
- U57462 Carter Road - From its junction with the U57461 Carter Road westwards for its entire length
- U57599 George Close - From its junction with the U57576 George Drive north-westwards and westwards for its entire length
- U57576 George Drive - From its junction with the U57461 Carter Road eastwards and northwards to its junction with the C282 Hall Lane
- U57577 Layton Close - From its junction with the U57576 George Drive for its entire length
