

**The Norfolk County Council
(Ryburgh, C335 Fakenham Road and Bridge Road)
(7.5 Tonnes Weight Restriction) Order 2024**

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(4) and 3(2) and 122 and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Ryburgh, C335 Fakenham Road and Bridge Road) (7.5 Tonnes Weight Limit Restriction) Order 2024 and shall come into effect on the 27th day of September 2024.

2. In this Order -

Any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. Unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

'agricultural motor vehicle', 'agricultural trailer', 'agricultural trailed appliance', and 'agricultural trailed appliance conveyor' shall have the same meaning as in Section 3 of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986";

'goods vehicle' shall have the same meaning as in Section 138(3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"Maximum Gross Weight" -

(a) in relation to a vehicle not drawing a trailer, means the maximum gross weight as defined in Regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986(b); and

(b) in relation to a vehicle drawing one or more trailers, the total weight obtained by taking the maximum gross weight (as so defined) of each vehicle in the combination and adding them together;

'public service vehicle' shall have the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

'public passenger transport service' shall have the same meaning as in section 63(10)(a) of the Transport Act 1985.


3. Save as provided in Article 4, no goods vehicle which has a maximum gross vehicle weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden proceed in the lengths of the C335 Fakenham Road/ Bridge Road from its junction with B1146 Dereham Road, Eastwards for a distance of 5416 metres to its junction with A1067 Norwich Road.

4. Nothing in Article 3 shall make it unlawful for any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order if the vehicle being used -
- (a) is in connection with the carrying out, in the said length of road of any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) the removal of obstructions to traffic;
 - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to any road of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (iv) the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011;
 - (b) is for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (c) is in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) requires access to premises within the length of restriction for the purposes of loading and unloading of goods;
 - (e) requires access to a final destination within the length of restriction;
 - (f) is a public service vehicle being used in connection with a public passenger transport service.
 - (g) is an agricultural motor vehicle/agricultural trailer/agricultural trailed appliance/agricultural trailed appliance conveyor requiring access to the locality.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
