

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (SPROWSTON, C283 SALHOUSE ROAD)

(30 M.P.H. AND 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2003

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along the C283 Salhouse Road from its junction with the C256 Woodside Road north-eastwards to a point 72 metres north-east of the centreline of its junction with the U51182 Harrisons Drive; at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. No person shall cause any vehicles to proceed along the C283 Salhouse Road from a point 72 metres north-east of the centreline of its junction with the U51182 Harrisons Drive north-eastwards to a point 750 metres north-east of the centreline of its junction with the U51182 Harrisons Drive at a speed not exceeding 40 m.p.h.
3. The following Order will become revoked on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

"The County council of Norfolk (Restricted Roads) (No.2) Order 1971" – in its entirety.
4. This Order comes into operation on the 12th day of September 2003 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Sprowston, C283 Salhouse Road) (30 m.p.h. and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 2003.
5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
