

The Norfolk County Council
(Acle, Cavell Road, Kemp Avenue and Martin Way)
(20 mph Speed Limit Zone) Order 2026

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Acle, Cavell Road, Kemp Avenue and Martin Way) (20 mph Speed Limit Zone) Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 17th day of August 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule

In the Town of Acle

20 mph Speed Limit Zone

Road	Description
U51728 Cavell Road	From its junction with U51271 Glover Road eastwards for its entire loop including its turning heads, a distance of 564 metres.
U51730 Kemp Avenue	From the mid-point of its junction with U51728 Cavell Road north-westwards and eastwards for its entire length, a distance of 272 metres.
U51729 Martin Way	From the mid-point of its junction with U51728 Cavell Road westwards for its entire length, a distance of 64 metres.
