

**The Norfolk County Council
(Antingham and Thorpe Market, A149 Cromer Road and U14369 Elderton Lane)
(50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2026**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Antingham and Thorpe Market, A149 Cromer Road and U14369 Elderton Lane) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2026 and shall come into effect on the 10th day of April 2026.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

Schedule

In the Parishes of Antingham and Thorpe Market

50 mph Speed Limit

Road	Description
A149 Cromer Road	From a point 40 metres south of its junction with the C297 Church Road for a distance of 2500 metres southwards
U14369 Elderton Lane	From its junction with the A149 Cromer Road for a distance of 20 metres eastwards
